APPLICATION OF MIDWEST INDEPENDENT TRANSMISSION SYSTEM OPERATOR, INC. TO INTERVENE

The Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. ("Midwest ISO"), by and through its counsel and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075, applies to intervene in this matter. In support of this Application, Midwest ISO states:

- 1. Midwest ISO is a not-for-profit corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of Delaware, with its principal place of business at 701 City Center Drive, Carmel, Indiana, 46032.
- 2. The Midwest ISO is a regional transmission organization (RTO) that monitors and controls the bulk electric system, for its transmission owner members and system users, and provides all customers with open access transmission service. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approved the Midwest ISO as the nation's first RTO on December 20, 2001. On February 1, 2002, the Midwest ISO began providing regional transmission service for the movement of bulk power over the transmission facilities within its footprint. Midwest ISO has operated real-time and day-ahead energy markets since April 1, 2005.
