REPLY OF SOUTHWESTERN BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY TO MID-MISSOURI GROUP'S RESPONSE TO MOTION TO SHORTEN TIME

Comes now Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and respectfully replies to the response of Mid-Missouri Group to SWBT's Motion to Shorten Time for Discovery Responses.

- 1. Mid-Missouri Group is opposed to shortening the time to respond to data requests on the basis that SWBT has unreasonably delayed in making the data requests. Mid-Missouri Group also asserts that the information requested is beyond the scope of the docket. Neither objection is meritorious.
- 2. The data requests filed by Southwestern Bell are designed to ferret out whether and which Independent Telephone Companies (ITCs) are engaged in a misuse of COS service in violation of SWBT's tariffs and the Commission's Order which adopted the present COS system. SWBT learned only recently of this potential fraudulent course of conduct and immediately submitted data requests to determine the scope of the misuse. The potential misuse includes (a) certain ITCs reselling and/or sharing COS service in violation of SWBT's tariff and (b) certain ITCs misreporting the number of lines which utilize COS services. The result of this conduct is that SWBT, as the PTC to certain ITCs suffers financial loss as a result of the misuse and under reporting of COS usage. Although as PTC SWBT is responsible for the provision of COS services, all customer contacts and billing are performed by the ITCs which are secondary
