MONTHLY CHARGE - A monthly public fire hydrant service charge shall be determined for each incorporated city, town or village and shall be computed in accordance with the following formula:	*

A = Number of Active water customers, except Sale for Resale.	*
BILLING - Billing will be rendered monthly in advance, consistent with the billing period for regular water service. Billing for this service shall be in addition to charges for regular water service. For each new active customer billing shall start with the first billing period. Customers terminating service within a billing period shall not be entitled to a refund of any part of a previously paid fire hydrant charge.	*
PAYMENT TERMS – Refer to Rule 10 for payment terms. In all cases of nonpayment of the public fire hydrant service charge, water service may be discontinued in accordance with the provisions of Rule 7.	*
ADJUSTMENT of fire hydrant service charge. The monthly fire hydrant service charge shall be adjusted annually on March 1 of each year, based on December 31 data of the previous year or, at its option, the Company may recompute the monthly service charge at any time to reflect changes in number of customers or fire hydrants in the incorporated city, town, or village that results in a variation of \$0.01 or more in the monthly charge.	*
