MOTION FOR WAIVER

COMES NOW UpLync Telecommunications, Inc. (UpLync" or "Applicant"), by its undersigned counsel, and hereby moves for waiver of noncompliance with Order dated September 16, 2003, and waiver of 4 CSR 3.510(1)(C). In support of this motion, movant states as follows:

- When the initial application was filed in this matter, the accompanying tariffs 1. were inadvertently omitted.
- 2. On or about September 16, 2003, an Order Directing Filing was entered directing applicant to file an interexchange tariff. At that time, the undersigned counsel first learned that no tariffs had been filed with the application. On or about September 19, 2003, applicant filed the tariffs (PSC Nos. 1 and 2) intended to be included with the application.
- 3. The tariffs filed on or about September 19, 2003, did not include an interexchange tariff. No interexchange tariff has been filed as of this date.
- Applicant continues to seek certificates to provide basic local exchange services 4. and interexchange telecommunication services. Applicant requests a waiver of 4 CSR 3.510(1)(C) to permit additional time to properly prepare and submit an IXC tariff. Applicant will not provide interexchange or non-switched interexchange services until its IXC tariff is

approved.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that compliance with the Order dated September 16, 2003, be waived and that the amended application be approved subject to Applicant's obligation to file an appropriate interexchange tariff at least 45 days prior to providing any interexchange services to any customer.
