
**DISSENTING OPINION OF COMMISSIONER CONNIE MURRAY**

I would deny the Motions to Intervene and quickly schedule a hearing limited to the Applicant's qualification to hold a certificate. The Commission should refrain from using this application to open a Pandora's box concerning issues that involve Internet services.

Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC seeks voluntarily to submit itself to our jurisdiction until such time as there is a final determination by this Commission, the FCC or some other competent administrative or judicial body that provision of VOIP is beyond state jurisdiction. The attempts by numerous interveners to subject VOIP services to endless delays and costly proceedings that would deprive consumers of a valuable service should not be countenanced.

Therefore, I dissent from today's order.
