**MOTION TO MODIFY ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE TO PROVIDE BASIC LOCAL, LOCAL  
EXCHANGE AND INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves that the Commission modify its *Order Granting Certificate to Provide Basic Local, Local Exchange and Interexchange Telecommunications Services* to incorporate the correct legal name of the applicant in the matter. In support of its *Motion*, Staff states:

1. In its initial Application in this matter, the applicant referred to its name in several different ways. Throughout most of the Application, the applicant was referred to as “Ironhorse, LLC,” and that was also the name reflected in the caption of the case. Staff then submitted its recommendation to the Commission also referencing the name “Ironhorse, LLC.”

2. However, no entity exists with authority to do business in Missouri under the name “Ironhorse, LLC.” The cover letter accompanying the Application and the signature line for the attorney filing the Application at the end of the Application both indicate the applicant was in fact called “Ironhorse Services, LLC.” Moreover, the Certificate of Registration of a Foreign Limited Liability Company that was submitted as a part of the Application clearly identified the applicant as Ironhorse Services, LLC.

3. Accordingly, Staff moves and recommends that the Commission take notice of the Certificate issued by the Missouri Secretary of State attached as Exhibit A to the Application,

and modify its order to reflect the correct, legal name of the applicant in this case as “Ironhorse Services, LLC.”

4. The Commission’s rule at 4 CSR 240-2.160(4) provides that the Commission may correct its own orders *nunc pro tunc*.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission modify its *Order Granting Certificate to Provide Basic Local, Local Exchange and Interexchange Telecommunications Services* to identify the correct legal entity, “Ironhorse Services, LLC.”




