## **VIDEO SERVICE AUTHORIZATION**

On October 10, 2007, Friendship Cable of Arkansas, Inc., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications, ("the Company") field a Notice of Change Application to change the Application filed on September 10, 2007. By order dated October 31, 2007, the Commission rejected the Notice of Change Application because the Notice added a political subdivision to the original Application; therefore requiring a new application and complete affidavit.

On November 13, 2007, Suddenlink filed its Supplemental Filing of Affidavit for Notice of Change Application pursuant to §67.2679.7 RSMo 2000 (Cum. Supp. 2007), requesting an application for video service authorization in the following political subdivision:

The Commission has reviewed the application filed by the Company and finds that it and the supplemental filing of the affidavit comply with the filing requirements set forth in §67.2679.7 RSMo 2000 (Cum. Supp. 2007).

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Friendship Cable of Arkansas, Inc., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications is granted authority to provide video service in the franchise area of the political subdivision set forth in the application and restated above; and
- 2. Friendship Cable of Arkansas, Inc., d/b/a Suddenlink Communications is granted authority to construct a video service network along, across, or on public rights-of-way for the delivery of video service to the extent the video service provider or an affiliate did not otherwise possess a valid authorization to occupy the public rights-of-way.
  - 3. This Order shall become effective on November 30, 2007.
  - 4. This case may be closed on December 1, 2007.
