VIDEO SERVICE AUTHORIZATION

Effective Date: August 27, 2008

On July 28, 2008, Windjammer Communications, LLC, (“the Company”) pursuant to §67.2679.7, RSMo 2000 (Cum. Supp. 2007), filed an application for video service authorization in the following political subdivisions:

| Political Subdivision | Fee Amount |
|------------------------------|-------------------|
| City of Marshall | 2.5% |
| Township of Chillicothe | 0% |
| Livingston County | 0% |
| Rich Hill Township | 0% |
| Dunklin County | 0% |

On August 8, 2008, Windjammer filed an amended Application which removed the City of Marshall from the Political Subdivisions listed in the July 28 Application.

On August 14, 2008, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a Staff Recommendation. Staff stated that a township is not defined as a political subdivision pursuant to Section 67.2677(11) RSMo 2000 (Cum. Supp. 2007). Staff recommended the Commission approve video service authorization to Windjammer for Livingston County, which includes the Township of Chillicothe and the Rich Hill Township.

The Commission has reviewed Staff's recommendation and the application filed by the Company and finds that it and the attached affidavit comply with the filing requirements set forth in § 67.2679.7, RSMo 2000 (Cum. Supp. 2007).

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Windjammer Communications, LLC is granted authority to provide video service in the franchise area of the following political subdivisions:

| Political Subdivision | Fee Amount |
|------------------------------|-------------------|
| Livingston County | 0% |
| Dunklin County | 0% |

As the townships are included within these subdivisions, as described above, authority to serve them specifically will not be granted or denied.

2. Windjammer Communications, LLC is granted authority to construct a video service network along, across, or on public rights-of-way for the delivery of video service to the extent the video service provider or an affiliate did not otherwise possess a valid authorization to occupy the public rights-of-way.

3. This Order shall become effective on August 27, 2008.

4. This case may be closed on August 27, 2008.
