## MOTION TO CANCEL REGISTRATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to cancel the certificates to provide basic local exchange, interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services and the registration to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol (IVoIP) services of SRInternet, LLC, (Company) and states:

- 1. The Commission previously granted certificates of service authority to provide basic local exchange, intrastate interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services to the Company in Case No. LA-2020-0300 on March 31, 2020. The Commission previously granted a registration to the Company to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol service authority in Case No. DA-2020-0299 on April 10, 2020.
- 2. The Company failed to submit an annual report to the Missouri Commission for calendar years 2020 and 2021. The requirement of a telecommunications company to file an annual report is identified in Sections 392.210 and 392.390, RSMo, and an IVoIP company in 392.550.3(7), RSMo, and 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(A). The Company has not responded to Staff's contacts to resolve the deficiency.

- 3. The Company failed to file its Statement of Revenue report and pay the Missouri Commission annual assessment for fiscal year 2023.<sup>1</sup> The requirement to file a Statement of Revenue report is identified in 20 CSR 4240-28.012(1)(B). The requirement to pay the Missouri Commission assessment is identified in Section 386.370, RSMo and an IVoIP company in 392.550.3(6), RSMo and 20 CSR 4240-28.012(2)(A). The Company has not responded to Staff's contacts to resolve these deficiencies.
- 4. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate, or in the present case, registration, pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."
- 5. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel the registration of service authority to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol service of SRInternet, LLC, and grant such other and further relief as is just in the circumstances.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> A company's assessment amount is determined by a factor identified on the commission's website and applied to a company's Missouri jurisdictional revenue identified on its Statement of Revenue report. If a company fails to file a Statement of Revenue report then the company's assessment is calculated using a Commission approved formula.
