RENEWAL NOTICE FOR AN INTENDED CASE

COMES NOW, Lincoln County Water and Sewer, LLC ("Lincoln County"), by and through counsel, Joshua Harden, to file this Notice Renewal for an Intended Case Notice pursuant to 4 CSR 240-4.017.

On January 4, 2019 Lincoln County filed its Notice of Intended Case and the Commission opened the above-referenced dockets. Under 4 CSR 240-4.017, if the expected case filing is not made within 180 days, the noticed case shall close. A noticed case filed on January 4, 2019 would have until July 3, 2019 to file the case.

While Lincoln County has worked diligently to file its application by July 3, 2019, the filing of Lincoln County's application for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) is not feasible within the 180 day time frame. Lincoln County files this Notice Renewal so that the case file is not closed necessitating a new docket number. Unless directed otherwise by the Commission, Lincoln County will treat this Notice Renewal as a new Intended Case Notice filing and would anticipate filing its CCN application between August 30, 2019 and December 28, 2019.
