ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND MAKING WEST TELECOM SERVICES, LLC (NKA INTRADO COMMUNICATIONS, LLC) A PARTY

This order provides notice of this application to interested parties and establishes a deadline for intervention and for requesting a hearing.

On September 27, 2021, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, filed an application with the Commission for approval of an amendment to a negotiated Interconnection Agreement with West Telecom Services, LLC (n/k/a Intrado Communications, LLC) ("Intrado") under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("Act"). AT&T Missouri states that they have entered into an amendment to their current Interconnection agreement that adopts amendments previously approved by the Commission.

Although Intrado is a party to the Agreement, it did not join in the application. Because Intrado is a necessary party to a full and fair adjudication of this matter, the Commission will add Intrado as a party to this case.

The Act provides that an Interconnection or Resale Agreement must be approved unless the state commission finds that the Agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the Agreement, or that implementation of the

Agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.¹ Section 252(e)(4) of the Act provides that if the Commission has not approved an Agreement within 90 days after submission, the Agreement shall be deemed approved. The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 15 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing. The Commission also finds that notice of this application shall be sent to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.
2. Intrado is made a party to this case.
3. Any party wishing to intervene or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than October 14, 2021, with:

4. The Staff of the Commission shall file a recommendation advising either approval or rejection of this Agreement and giving the reasons therefor no later than October 29, 2021.
5. This order shall be effective when issued.
