**NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING REQUEST
OF EARLIER EFFECTIVE DATE**

Issue Date: September 3, 2009

On July 23, 2009, Time Warner Entertainment Advance/Newhouse (TWEAN) d/b/a Time Warner Cable filed a notice of change application for video service authorization in various political subdivisions. On August 11, 2009, the Commission granted Time Warner authorization to provide video service in the political subdivisions set forth in the notice of change application.

Time Warner's notice of change application indicated various effective dates would apply to particular areas. The Commission's August 11, 2009 authorization was effective upon issuance for all areas Time Warner requested in its July 23 application. The Commission does not have jurisdiction to enforce the application of the fee amounts and believed the effective dates requested by Time Warner were provided to the Commission as a courtesy.

On September 2, 2009, Time Warner filed a letter, dated August 25, requesting the authorization for the City of Independence be changed from October 1, 2009 to September 4, 2009. The Commission acknowledges Time Warner's request of an earlier effective date

of September 4, 2009, for the City of Independence. No further action by the Commission is required. Therefore this case may be closed.
