have requested a waiver for good cause as allowed by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1)(D).

This language is incorporated in the application form and affidavit included on the Commission's website as paragraph 9 of the affidavit.

The Application is also deficient in that it is not signed by an attorney licensed to practice law in Missouri as required by Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.040, and 2.080(1). See also, Reed v. Labor and Indus. Relations Com'n, 789 S.W.2d 19 (Mo. banc. 1990)

The Commission will not take action on Suddenlink Communications' Notice of Change Application seeking to expand video service until these deficiencies are corrected.
