ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On June 21, 2012, Fidelity Telephone Company issued a tariff revision that will alter its state access tariff provisions regarding intrastate Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) traffic. That tariff revision carries a thirty-day effective date of July 21. However, along with its tariff revision, Fidelity Telephone filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the tariff revision on an expedited basis so that the tariff can go into effect on July 13.

Before acting on Fidelity Telephone's tariff, the Commission will require a recommendation from its Staff. The Commission will also establish a deadline for any other party that wants to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Fidelity Telephone Company's tariff no later than June 29, 2012.
- 2. Any other party that wants to file a recommendation regarding Fidelity Telephone Company's tariff shall do so no later than June 29, 2012.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
