**MCI WORLDCOM COMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S**  
**REQUEST TO INTERVENE**

Comes now MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. (MCIWC) pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.075 and for its Request to Intervene states to the Commission:

1. MCIWC is a Delaware corporation in good standing duly authorized to conduct business in Missouri with regulatory offices at 701 Brazos, Suite 600, Austin, Texas 78701. MCIWC is authorized as a competitive interexchange carrier under certificate granted and tariffs approved by the Commission.

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3. On or about March 25, 2004, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a SBC Missouri submitted a proposed revision to its P.S.C. Mo. No. 36 Access Services Tariff. On April 22, 2004, the Commission issued an order suspending the tariff until May 7, 2004.

6. MCIWC seeks to intervene in this proceeding because the Commission's decision will affect its interests as a provider of telecommunications services in competition against and a purchaser of access services from SBC Missouri.

7. MCIWC's interests as a telecommunications company are different from those of the general public. Furthermore, MCIWC's intervention in this proceeding is in the public interest because of its interest in enhancing competition and because of its expertise in the telecommunications industry.

8. MCIWC opposes SBC Missouri's proposed tariff for the reasons identified by AT&T in its pleadings.

WHEREFORE, MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., respectfully requests the Commission to issue its order granting its Request to Intervene.
