## 2009 ANNUAL LEAK SURVEY REPORT

COMES NOW Missouri Gas Energy ("MGE"), a division of Southern Union Company, in accordance with the Order Approving Application in this case, and notifies the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) as follows:

- 1. On June 12, 2008, the Commission issued its Order Approving Extension of Time to Replace Mains and Service Lines at Malang Mobile Home Park (Order Approving Extension) in this case. The Order Approving Extension, among other things, directed that "Missouri Gas Energy shall file annual leak survey reports regarding the leak surveys it makes and any leaks it detects at Malang Mobile Home Park. The reports shall also indicate what progress is being made toward a resolution of the question of when the park will close or whether the mains and service lines will be replaced. The reports shall be filed in this case." MGE provides the following information as its 2009 Annual Report.
- 2. Leak surveys were conducted at the Malang Trailer Park (formerly known as the Heistland Mobile Home Park) on February 20, 2008, and on August 6, 2008. No leaks were detected during either survey.
- 3. A meter inventory conducted on August 6, 2008, revealed 13 active meters and 23 empty risers. MGE will continue to monitor the condition of the Park on the established leak survey frequencies. MGE plans to conduct its next leak survey prior to February 6, 2009.

- 4. As previously reported, as of January 4, 2008, the Malang Trailer Park was sold by John Tullis to Kevin York. MGE has had difficulty contacting Mr. York to discuss his plans as to the future of the park. As the Commission may recall, this issue was discussed with Mr. York last year within the context of MGE's motion for extension (*See* Order Approving Extension of Time to Replace Mains and Service Lines at Malang Mobile Home Park, issued in this case on June 12, 2008).
- 5. On January 15, 2009, MGE sent Mr. York a certified letter informing him of MGE's need to discuss the future of the park, to include the consequences if the Park is not closed and MGE must begin construction. A MGE representative discussed this matter with Mr. York after the referenced letter was sent. However, no resolution was reached with Mr. York. It is MGE's understanding that Mr. York is planning to contact the Gas Safety section of the Commission Staff to further inquire about this matter.

WHEREFORE, MGE respectfully requests that the Commission consider this report to comply with the Commission's Order Approving Extension and, thereafter, issue such orders as the Commission shall find to be reasonable and just.
