**RESPONSE TO COMMISSION ORDER  
DIRECTING FILING AND SUPPLEMENT  
TO PROTEST, REQUEST FOR SUSPENSION  
AND APPLICATION TO INTERVENE  
OF AG PROCESSING INC.**

Comes now AG PROCESSING INC, a COOPERATIVE ("AGP"), and pursuant to the Commission's March 18, 2003 Order Directing Filing states:

1. AGP apologizes for failing to attach copies of the tariffs of concern and for any inconvenience caused thereby.
2. AGP's filing of March 17, 2003 is supplemented by attaching hereto the following tariff sheets:

P.S.C. MO. NO. 2, 3rd Revised Sheet No. 19  
P.S.C. MO. NO. 1, 10th Revised Sheet No. 1  
P.S.C. MO. NO. 1, 8th Revised Sheet No. 2  
P.S.C. MO. NO. 1, 1st Revised Sheet No. 27.

3. AGP is a customer in the St. Joseph service area. Its interest is specific to the rates that pertain to that service area. The Missouri-American proposal is made, it appears, not only regarding the St. Joseph service area, but with respect to all other areas in which water or sewer service is provided by Missouri-American. While AGP's concerns are specific to St. Joseph, by attaching only those tariffs, we do not wish to suggest that the issues raised are any less pertinent with

respect to other service areas, nor it be appropriate to infer that we are in any way waiving our concerns regarding the St. Joseph service area because we are not listing similar tariff proposals that would impact other service areas.

4. The filings identified as P.S.C. Mo. No. 2 appear to relate to Tracking No. JW-2003-1635; filings identified as P.S.C. Mo. No. 1 appear to relate to Tracking No. JW-2003-1669. Filings identified to P.S.C. Mo. No. 3 appear to relate to Tracking No. JW-2003-1674 and pertain to the Jefferson City service area. We are unable to identify with greater precision in which of what appears to have been three (or possibly four) separate tariff filings the above-listed sheets are contained. Copies were obtained from EFIS and the transmittal letters in two of the filings appeared to be identical. There were four transmittal letters, three dated February 28, 2003 and one dated March 10, 2003.

5. As supplemented by this filing, AGP's March 17, 2003 filing is reaffirmed.

WHEREFORE, AGP prays: (a) that the proposed tariffs containing the above-mentioned proposals be suspended pending review of the filing and any supporting documentation; (b) that depending upon such analysis that a hearing or other process may be needed and requested; and (c) that AGP be permitted to intervene herein and be made a party hereto with all rights to have notice of and participate in hearings to present evidence, cross-examine witnesses, file briefs and participate in argument,

should any be had; and (d) for all other needful and proper relief appropriate in the premises.

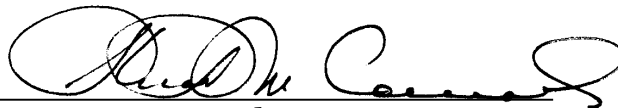

of Water ServiceRule 8 BILLS FOR WATER SERVICE

- (a) The charges for water service shall be at the rates specified in the applicable rate schedules. The point of delivery of service shall be at the outlet or Customer's side of the meter installation for all metered service or at the property line for all other classes. Service charges for connection (turn-on) or disconnection (turn-off) are set forth in Rule 12.
- (b) A Customer who has made application for water service to a premises shall be held liable for all charges for water furnished to such premise until the Customer notifies the Company to discontinue service.
- (c) All bills for water service are net, and are due and payable within ten (10) days after date of bill.
- (d) A separate bill shall be rendered for each meter installation, and the use of water by the same Customer in different premises or localities will not be combined. Each meter installation shall stand by itself.
- (e) Each Customer is responsible for furnishing the Company with his correct address. Failure to receive bills will not be considered an excuse for non-payment nor reason to permit an extension of the date when the account would be considered delinquent.
- (f) Bills and notices relating to the Company or its business will be mailed or delivered to the mailing address entered in the Customer's application unless the Company is notified by the Customer of a change of address.

- (A) Private fire service charges, at the option of the Company, will be rendered annually, semi-annually, quarterly or monthly and payable in advance. Registration on a detector check meter will be included on the appropriate bill immediately following registration. +
- (B) This left blank.
- (C) Bills for water service by meter measurement shall be rendered for monthly or quarterly periods at the option of the Company and ending as such dates as may be determined by the Company.
- (D) Special charges shall be payable upon demand.
- (E) All bills for water service are net, and are due and payable within ten (10) days after date of bill. +
- (F) Customers are responsible for furnishing the Company with their correct address. Failure to receive bills will not be considered an excuse for non-payment or permit an extension of the date when the account would be considered delinquent. +
- (G) All bills will be sent to the address entered in the application unless the Company is notified in writing by the Customer of any change of address.
- (H) Payments shall be made at places conveniently located within the district service are as may be designated by the Company.

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
