ORDER DIRECTING CLARIFICATION OF APPLICATION

On July 23, 2009, Time Warner Entertainment-Advance/Newhouse (TWEAN) d/b/a Time Warner Cable filed a notice of change application for authorization to expanded video service to additional areas. Both the Missouri Secretary of State's website and the Missouri Public Service Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) show the parent company, Time Warner Entertainment, L.P., has registered Time Warner Entertainment – Advance/Newhouse Partnership as the fictitious name for the parent company. The Commission does not have record of the fictitious name, Time Warner Entertainment – Advance/Newhouse (TWEAN) having been registered to use the fictitious name Time Warner Cable. It thus appears that the applicant, TWEAN, is itself just a fictitious "doing business as" name for an unnamed parent company.

Therefore, the Commission will direct the applicant to file an amended notice identifying the parent company that is seeking to expand video service to additional areas.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applicant Time Warner Entertainment – Advance/Newhouse, d/b/a Time Warner Cable shall file an amended Notice of Change Application no later than August 12, 2009, identifying the parent company that is seeking to expand video service to additional areas.
2. This order shall be effective immediately upon issuance.
