AMENDED MOTION FOR FINDING OF NECESSITY FOR RULEMAKING

COMES NOW the Director of the Division of Manufactured Homes and Modular Units of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Director"), by and through the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Office of General Counsel, and for his Amended Motion For Finding of Necessity For Rulemaking states as follows:

- 1. Attached as Attachment A is the Director's Recommendation to the Commission on the proposed rulemaking. Included in the Recommendation is an analysis of the fiscal impact and effectiveness of the rule, both to the state as well as to any private or public person or entity affected by this rulemaking.
- 2. The Director proposes to amend Rule 4 CSR 240-120.100 to clarify the requirements to which new manufactured homes are to be set up and installed.
- 3. This rulemaking is necessary to assist the Manufactured Housing Department in making determinations about the proper set up of new manufactured homes.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 700.040.5 RSMo (1999), the Commission has the authority to promulgate rules to make effective Sections 700.010 to 700.115. Section 700.100.3(6) requires dealers to arrange for proper setup of manufactured homes.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully requests that the Commission, based upon reasonably available empirical data including an assessment of the effectiveness and costs both to the state and to any private or public person or entity affected, find that the proposed amendment to 4 CSR 240-120.100 – Code is necessary to assist the Manufactured Housing Department in making determinations about the proper set up of new manufactured homes.

4 CRS 240-120.100 – Code is being amended to clarify the requirements to which new manufactured homes are to be set up or installed. The rule generally specifies that new manufactured homes shall be set up or installed according to the manufacturer's installation instruction manual.

The new rule is necessary to assist the Manufactured Housing Department in making determinations about the proper set up of new manufactured homes. There is no fiscal impact resulting from this proposed rule amendment.

Staff recommends that the Commission find that a rulemaking to propose 4 CRS 240-120.100 is necessary.
