On May 1, 2015, Magnum Networks, LLC (Magnum) filed an application with the Commission for certificates of service to provide basic local exchange, non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and to classify said services and the company as competitive. Magnum is a Texas limited liability company, with its principal place of business at 771 E. Hwy 80, Suite 201, Forney, Texas 75126. With its application, the company also filed tariffs with an effective date of June 15, 2015.

The Commission will direct its Data Center to send notice as set out in the ordered paragraphs below. The Commission will also set a deadline for any applications to intervene and will direct the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send notice of this application to all telecommunications carriers certificated to operate in the state of Missouri.

2. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to intervene no later than May 22, 2015.

3. No later than May 29, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation regarding the application.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
