Dear Mr. Woodruff,

West Safety Communications Inc. ("Company") hereby notifies the Commission that the Company has changed its name to Intrado Safety Communications, Inc. The Company respectfully requests that the Commission issue an updated certificate, if applicable, to reflect the Company's name as "Intrado Safety Communications, Inc." and update the Company name in all Commission records. The Company is authorized to provide basic local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri pursuant to authority granted in Case No. TA-2002-154 and File No. CA-2011-0360 under the name of Intrado Communications Inc. The Company changed its name to West Safety Communications Inc. in File No. CN-2016-0220.

A copy of the Company's Amended Certificate of Authority of a Foreign Corporation on file with the Missouri Secretary of State is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Attached hereto as Exhibit B is a replacement local telecommunications tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1, with a requested effective date of April 12, 2020. This tariff, which replaces in its entirety the Company's P.S.C. No. 1 currently on file with the Commission, contains the same terms and conditions of service previously approved by the Commission. No changes have been made to the tariff except to reflect the Company's new name and to sequentially number the pages and correct section numbering as necessary.

The Company has changed its name as part of a recent rebranding and marketing campaign by its ultimate parent company, Intrado Corporation f/k/a West Corporation. The Company's name change does not entail any restructuring, merger or other transaction impacting the corporate existence or management of the Company. Customer notice is not required because the Company does not currently have any customers in Missouri.

COMPANY SERVICES

Emergency Telecommunications Services (9-1-1 Emergency Services)

- 9-1-1 Emergency Services are telecommunications services that permit a Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) to receive emergency calls placed by dialing the number 9-1-1, and/or permit emergency calls originated by personal communications devices.
- 9-1-1 Emergency Services include 9-1-1 Routing and Transfer Services that use a call routing system to either directly perform the selective routing of an emergency call to the appropriate PSAP, or may be used to hand-off the call to a separate 9-1-1 Service Provider for call completion to the appropriate 9-1-1.
- 9-1-1 Emergency Services include a data management service, a call delivery service, a call routing service, and a 9-1-1 Automatic Location Identification (ALI) service. The Customer is the Governing Authority that orders service and is responsible for the payment of the charges and compliance with the terms and conditions of the contracts entered into with Intrado Safety Communications, Inc.

Intrado Safety Communications, Inc. concurs in the telephone exchange boundary maps of Missouri incumbent local exchange carriers. To the extent applicable, Intrado Safety Communications, Inc. recognizes Missouri Public Service Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-34 – Emergency Telephone Service Standards. Facilities used in the provision of Intrado Safety Communications, Inc.'s services are constructed to meet specifications negotiated by the Company and the Customer on an Individual Case Basis. All charges are offered to Customers in writing and on a nondiscriminatory basis. Copies of Intrado Safety Communications, Inc.'s service contracts will be made available to the staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission as requested on a proprietary basis.

Service is provided pursuant to contracts negotiated with the Customer. Service descriptions and rates are included in contracts along with terms and conditions of service, payment requirements, and limitations of liability.

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
