STAFF RESPONSE AND RECOMMENDATION

COMES Now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its response and recommendation states:

- 1. On October 28, 2009, AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc., and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri (collectively, AT&T), filed a motion requesting that the Commission suspend and investigate the access services tariff (Tariff No. JX-2010-0151) submitted by Bandwidth.com CLEC, LLC, on October 7, 2009. The tariff effective date has been extended and is presently scheduled to become effective on June 24, 2010. On June 17, 2010, AT&T withdrew its Motion.
- 2. The Staff recommends that the tariff be approved without suspension or further proceedings in this matter. The Staff has reviewed the proposed tariff and has no objection to its approval or to allowing it to take effect by operation of law. As this tariff has never been suspended, no formal Commission action need be taken.
