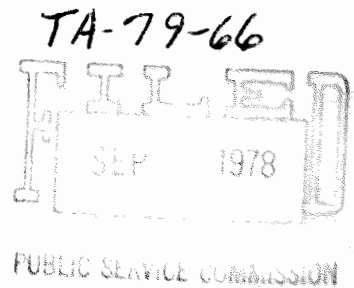

NON-INTERCONNECTED PAGING SERVICE


Comes now Control Center, Inc., and shows to the Commission that:

1. The applicant, Control Center, Inc. is a Missouri Corporation in good standing, with an address of 227 East Capitol Avenue, Jefferson City, Missouri.
2. There is a public need for non-interconnected paging service in Jefferson City, Missouri, and the area within a thirty ¹⁵(30) mile radius of Jefferson City, and the public interest would best be served by granting this application.
3. The applicant is financially capable of rendering radio paging service on a continuing basis for the area to be served if this application is approved. The applicant's financial statement is attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully set out herein.
4. The applicant is technically capable of rendering radio paging service on a continuing basis in the area sought to be served by this application.
5. That applicant is seeking authority from the Federal Communications Commission for Radio Common Carrier Authority simultaneous with the filing of this application.

Wherefore, the applicant requests the Commission to enter an order granting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to the applicant to operate a non-interconnected paging service for Jefferson City, Missouri and all areas within a thirty ¹⁵(30)

mile radius of Jefferson City, Missouri.

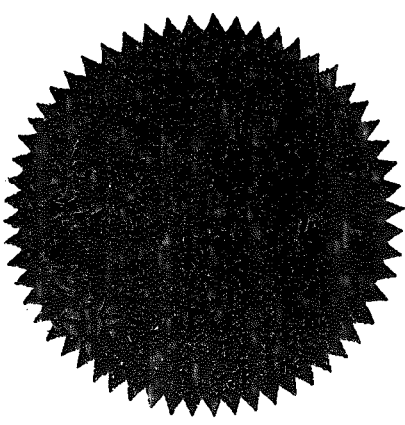

To loan and otherwise invest funds from time to time, secured or unsecured for such time and upon such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors may authorize;

To engage in the general business of real estate and communications;

And have and to exercise all powers necessary or incident to the carrying out of corporate purposes of a "FOR-PROFIT CORPORATION" organized under the laws of the State of Missouri and enjoy all rights and powers which now or at any future time hereafter may be granted to or exercised by the corporate charter for all general business purposes.


