ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

On August 24, 2007, Charter Fiberlink, LLC, filed a motion asking the Commission to issue its standard protective order to establish the means by which confidential information can be protected from disclosure to the public and competing companies. On January 30, 2007, the Commission's new rule concerning the handling of confidential information, 4 CSR 240-2.135, went into effect. That rule supplants the standard protective order that the Commission has routinely issued in the past. As a result, the protective order sought by Charter is no longer necessary, and the motion asking for such an order will be denied.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Charter Fiberlink, LLC's Motion for Protective Order is denied.

2. This order shall become effective on August 27, 2007.
