## **ORDER RECOGNIZING NAME CHANGE**

On September 21, 2015, WiMacTel, Inc. filed a letter asking the Commission to recognize that it is changing the name under which it provides telecommunications services in Missouri from WiMacTel, Inc. to WiMacTel, Inc. d/b/a Intellicall Operator Services. Staff filed a recommendation regarding WiMacTel's notice of name change on October 2, advising the Commission that the notice of name change complies with the Commission's requirements. Staff recommends the Commission recognize the name change. No one has opposed the name change.

The Commission has reviewed the notice of name change and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the name change should be recognized. Because this action is unopposed and prompt recognition of the name change is appropriate, the Commission will make this order effective in less than thirty days.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission recognizes that WiMacTel, Inc. has changed the name under which it operates in Missouri to WiMacTel, Inc. d/b/a Intellicall Operator Services.

2. This order shall be effective on October 12, 2015.
3. This file shall be closed on October 13, 2015.
