**ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Pending herein is Respondent Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's (SWBT) Motion to Compel Responses to Data Requests, filed on June 16, 2000. Complainants MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., Brooks Fiber Communications of Missouri, Inc., and BroadSpan Communications, Inc., d/b/a Primary Network Communications, Inc. (collectively Complainants), replied on July 3, 2000, and the motion is now ripe for determination. However, a difficulty is posed by the fact that the hearing in this case is set to begin on July 19, 2000. Should SWBT prevail on its motion to compel, it appears that it would be hampered in its ability to actually use the information thereby acquired in its defense at hearing.

For this reason, the Commission will, *sua sponte*, reschedule the hearing in this matter to August 23, 24 and 25, 2000. In that way, a

sufficient interval will be provided for the Commission to rule on the pending motion to compel.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That the procedural schedule previously adopted for this case is modified in that the evidentiary hearing shall be held on August 23, 24 and 25, 2000, commencing on August 23 at 8:30 a.m. The hearing scheduled for July 19, 20 and 21, 2000, is canceled.

2. That the hearing will be held at the Commission's offices in Jefferson City, Missouri. This hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans With Disabilities Act. 3. That this order shall become effective on July 19, 2000.
