Dear Mr. Roberts:

On behalf of our client, Ionex Telecommunications, Inc., we submitted a letter dated September 27, 1999 notifying the Missouri Public Service Commission, that, for purposes of the above-captioned application, Ionex Telecommunications, LLC "has become" Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. We write to clarify that the paperwork creating Ionex Telecommunications, LLC was never completed by corporate counsel. Before that paperwork was finalized, a decision was made instead for Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. to be the company proposing to acquire Feist Long Distance Service, Inc. and Telecom Resources, Inc., d/b/a TRINetwork, Inc. Accordingly, Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. should be substituted for Ionex Telecommunications, LLC for purposes of this application.

This clarification does not change any other information provided in the initial application, or in our recent letter alerting the Missouri Public Service Commission to minor revisions to Ionex's corporate structure. The ownership of Ionex Telecommunications, Inc. remains unchanged. The illustrative organizational chart in our recent letter continues to reflect

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the corporate structure of the Parties prior to and immediately following the transfer of control. For your convenience, another copy of that chart is attached hereto.¹

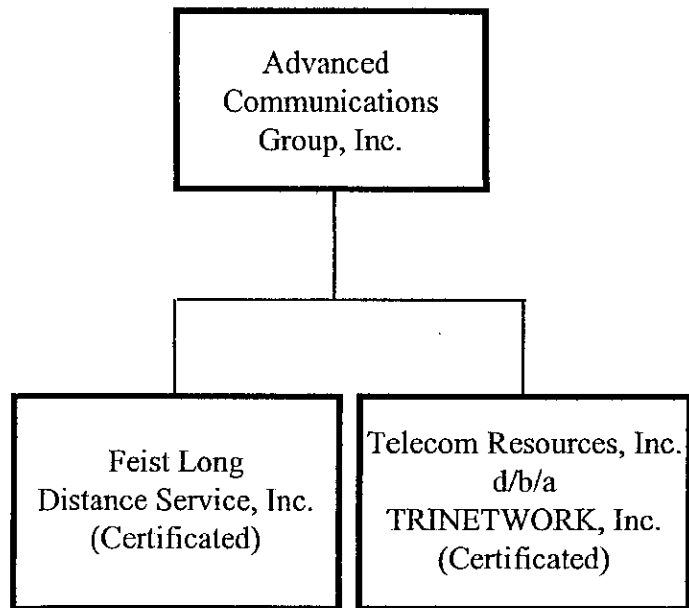

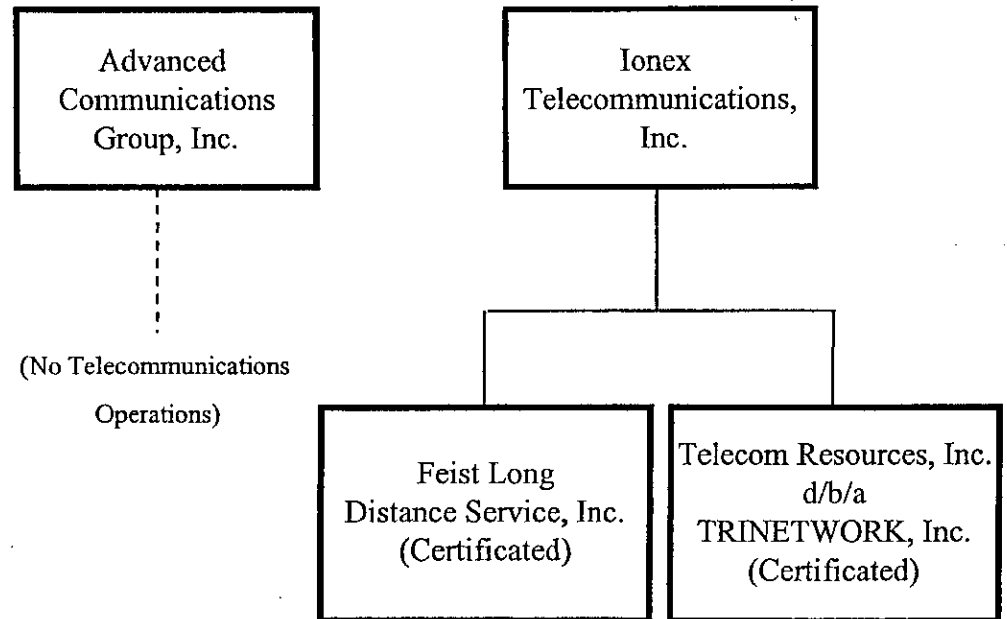
