MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION TO REFLECT CHANGE OF NAME OF APPLICANT AND TO FILE REVISED APPENDIX C TO APPLICATION

Comes now FairPoint Communications Solutions Corp. ("FairPoint" or "Applicant"), f/k/a FairPoint Communications Corp., and in support of its Motion to Amend Application to Reflect Change of Name of Applicant and to File Revised Appendix C to Application states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

- 1. On February 22, 2000, Applicant filed an application with the Commission requesting authority to provide basic local telecommunications service in portions of the State of Missouri. At the time the application was filed, Applicant's name was FairPoint Communications Corp. On June 8, 2000, Applicant formally changed its name to FairPoint Communications Solutions Corp. FairPoint attached a copy of its Certificate of Amendment issued by the Missouri Secretary of State reflecting the change of name to its filing in Case No. TO-2000-839 which certificate is hereby incorporated by reference. The Commission approved the change of name for Applicant on its interexchange tariffs previously filed in Case No. TA-2000-515.
- 2. As Appendix C to its original Application, Applicant filed financial statements of its parent, MJD Communications. MJD Communications is now known as FairPoint

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Communications Corp. Attached to this Motion is a revised Appendix C containing updated current financial statements as well as other financial information regarding the Applicant and its parent company, portions of which are marked "Proprietary." On this same date, Applicant is also filing a Motion for Protective Order and requesting that this proprietary information not be publicly disclosed.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion to Amend Application to Reflect Change of Name of Applicant and to File Revised Appendix C to Application and grant such further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.



Announces Closing of a \$250 Million Senior Secured Credit Facility And Withdrawal of a Planned \$230 Million Initial Public Offering

Charlotte, N.C., November 10, 2000 - FairPoint Communications, Inc. (FairPoint) today announced the closing of a \$250 million senior secured credit facility for its competitive communications subsidiary, FairPoint Communications Solutions Corp. (FairPoint Solutions). With this credit facility in place, FairPoint has obtained the necessary debt capital to fund its current business plan and announced it will not pursue a planned initial public equity offering at this time. FairPoint filed for a \$230 million initial public offering in May of this year. Proceeds were slated to fund FairPoint Solutions' continued business and market expansion.

FairPoint Solutions successfully closed a \$250 million senior secured credit facility yesterday that will fund its planned business and market growth. "We and our private equity investors are very pleased we could obtain this credit facility given the turbulent market conditions effecting the emerging telecommunications sector. This transaction confirms FairPoint Solutions' ability to access capital in the most difficult of markets and is a strong affirmation by the lending group of our business plan and execution capability. This credit facility will provide the necessary funding to continue the growth and success of our competitive communications business", commented Walter E. Leach, Jr., Chief Financial Officer.

The \$250 million senior secured credit facility was co-arranged by First Union Securities, Inc. and Bank of America Securities, LLC. Other participating financial institutions included Bankers Trust Company serving as documentation agent, CitiCorp USA, Inc., DLJ Capital Funding, Inc., CoBank, ACB, and CIT Group. First Union, Bank of America, CitiCorp, Bankers Trust and DLJ are also equity investors in FairPoint. The credit facility provides a revolving term tranche of \$75 million with the opportunity to increase the commitment by an additional \$50 million and a \$175 million term tranche.

FairPoint is a national, facilities-based provider of voice, data and Internet services. FairPoint was begun in 1993 for the purpose of acquiring and operating rural traditional telephone companies. Since its inception, FairPoint has acquired 28 traditional telephone companies, which currently operate in 17 states providing service to more than 236,000 subscribers. In April 1998, FairPoint launched its competitive communications subsidiary, FairPoint Communications Solutions Corp. by entering less competitive ex-urban markets. FairPoint Solutions targets the small and medium-sized business customers in these ex-urban areas, or Tier IV and select Tier III markets, which typically have populations of less than 100,000. FairPoint offers an integrated suite of communications services including traditional voice services such as local, intra and inter-state access, long distance and enhanced calling services; and its data offerings include dial-up and high-speed Internet access (principally utilizing digital subscriber line or DSL technology), frame relay and Web hosting. Currently, FairPoint Solutions operates in over 200 markets reaching more than 100,000 access lines. FairPoint is headquartered in Charlotte, North Carolina.
