# MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE COST STUDIES OUT OF TIME AND WAIVER OF COMMISSION RULE 4 CSR 240-2.085

#### MOTION TO FILE OUT OF TIME

- 1. Due to the complex and voluminous nature of the cost studies, as well as the practical and logistical difficulties of coordinating, combining, and copying the cost studies for twenty-four (24) different companies that employ several different consultants, the undersigned were unable to file the cost studies by the July 1, 2002 deadline.
- 2. The cost studies and Mr. Robert Schoonmaker's Schedule RCS-8 (which contains summary data from the cost studies) are being filed one day late on July 2, 2002 along with this Motion. This one day delay should not result in prejudice to any party.
