MOTION TO EXTEND TIME WITHIN WHICH
TO FILE A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Comes now **Trans National Telecommunications, Inc.** (hereinafter Trans National) and
for its above-entitled Motion states the following to the Commission:

1. On February 1, 2000, the Commission entered its order granting intervention to
Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and directing the filing of a procedural schedule. Pursuant
to the order, a proposed procedural schedule is due to be filed with the Commission as of February
16, 2000.


2. Since the Commission entered the order, Trans National proposed a stipulation by
which the parties could dispose of this case and the same is now in circulation. Trans National
submits that there is a reasonable likelihood that this matter will be resolved on the basis of a
unanimous stipulation and the filing of a procedural schedule will not be necessary.

3. The parties need additional time to fully negotiate the terms of the stipulation. Trans
National estimates that an additional thirty days would be sufficient time for that purpose. If
negotiations should fail, a proposed procedural schedule will be submitted

WHEREFORE, based upon the above and foregoing, Trans National respectfully requests
the Commission to enter an order extending the time within which to file a proposed procedural
schedule for at least thirty days, up to and including March 16, 2000, together with such other relief

the Commission deems appropriate.


