- 1. On February 1, 2000, the Commission entered its order granting intervention to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and directing the filing of a procedural schedule. Pursuant to the order, a proposed procedural schedule is due to be filed with the Commission as of February 16, 2000.
- 2. Since the Commission entered the order, Trans National proposed a stipulation by which the parties could dispose of this case and the same is now in circulation.
