MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

COMES NOW, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE"), by and through
its counsel, and hereby moves pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.085 that the Missouri Public Service
Commission ("Commission") issue its standard protective order in this proceeding on the following
grounds:

1. Concurrently, with the filing of this Motion, AmerenUE and Callaway Electric
Cooperative ("Callaway") filed a Joint Application requesting that the Commission, among other
things, issue an order: approving a change in the electric supplier for approximately 800 structures
in Audrain, Boone, Callaway, Montgomery and Warren Counties from AmerenUE to Callaway
pursuant to Section 393.106, RSMo. 2000; approving a change in the electric supplier for
approximately 600 structures in Audrain, Boone, Callaway, Montgomery and Warren Counties
from Callaway to AmerenUE pursuant to Section 394.315, RSMo. 2000, and authorizing the sale,
transfer, and assignment of certain electric distribution facilities, easements, and other rights in
accordance with a Contract for Purchase and Sale of Distribution Facilities dated October 9, 2001
(the "Contract") pursuant to Section 393.190, RSMo. 2000.

2. AmerenUE anticipates filing direct testimony in this case that contains information
that would be classified as either "Highly Confidential" or "Confidential" in accordance with the

Commission's standard protective order because said testimony contains the monetary consideration paid to AmerenUE to transfer its electrical distribution facilities to Callaway in accordance with the Contract. It is highly likely that AmerenUE will negotiate with other rural electric cooperatives either to purchase or sell distribution facilities. Having the amount of monetary consideration paid by Callaway to AmerenUE available to other rural electric cooperatives could significantly impact AmerenUE's ability to negotiate a favorable price. This information cannot be found in any other public document.

3. AmerenUE also anticipates that it may be asked to provide additional "Highly Confidential" or "Proprietary" information in this proceeding.

4. The Commission has recognized, in numerous cases, that there is a genuine need to protect certain confidential or proprietary information from disclosure.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE respectfully requests that the Commission issue its standard protective order in this case.
