**MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFF**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves that the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority it has granted to North American Telephone Network, LLC to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri, as well as its tariff. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

1. On May 29, 1996, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services to North American Telephone Network, LLC in Case No. TA-96-310, and approved its tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1, in the same case.

2. Now, North American Telephone Network, LLC, through a letter from Rick Stevenson, chief operating officer of the company, has asked the Commission to cancel its certificate of service authority because it has ceased operating in Missouri. See Appendix A.

3. North American Telephone Network, LLC owes no assessments. It has failed to submit its annual report for calendar year 2006, but has submitted previous annual reports. No formal complaints have been filed against the company since the commencement of the Electronic Filing and Information System, and any informal complaints or inquiries received have been closed.

4. North American Telephone Network, LLC is a Georgia limited liability company registered to do business in Missouri with the Missouri Secretary of State.

5. Because North American Telephone Network, LLC has requested cancellation of its certificate; and because it is not providing telecommunications service in Missouri; the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling North American Telephone Network, LLC's certificate of service authority, as well as its tariff.

6. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2006), which provides:

"Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo.App. 1989).

7. This pleading is being served on the address provided by the company to the Commission via certified mail, as well as upon its Missouri registered agent.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of North American Telephone Network, LLC to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services; and also its tariff, P.S.C. Mo. No. 1.




