## ORDER CANCELING PAYPHONE CERTIFICATE

On June 12, 2002, Gale Wachsnicht filed an application for cancellation of certificate, asking the Missouri Public Service Commission to cancel a certificate of authority. The Commission issued a certificate to provide private pay telephone service to Gale Wachsnicht d/b/a Wavelength Ltd. On February 3, 1998, in Case No. TA-98-245.

Staff of the Commission, upon reviewing its records, has determined that Gale Wachsnicht does not have any unpaid assessments for the fiscal years 2000, 2002 and 2003. Gale Wachsnicht did not submit a statement of revenue for fiscal year 2001. Staff found no pending matters before the Commission involving the Gale Wachsnicht d/b/a Wavelength Ltd.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected...."

The Commission has reviewed the application and the official file and finds that the Certificate of Service Authority granted to Gale Wachsnicht d/b/a Wavelength Ltd. in case number TA-98-245 will be canceled.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the certificate of authority granted in case number TA-98-245 to Gale Wachsnicht will be canceled on June 29, 2002.
  - 2. That this case may be closed on June 30, 2002.
