### **ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE TO MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND ESTABLISHING A TIME FOR A RESPONSE**

On March 27, 2007, Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T") submitted, for Commission approval, revisions and additions to its P.S.C. Mo. - No. 35, General Exchange Tariff. The new tariff filing proposes to introduce 511 service and it bears an effective date of April 26, 2007.

Contemporaneously with its tariff filing, AT&T filed a motion for expedited treatment requesting that its tariff be allowed to take effect within ten business days of its filing, i.e. April 10, 2007.<sup>1</sup> In support of its motion to expedite, AT&T asserts that major reconstruction will begin soon on Interstate Highway 64 in the St. Louis area and the Missouri Department of Transportation ("MoDOT") has advised AT&T that it is preparing to deploy a travel information service for callers in Franklin, Jefferson, St. Charles and St. Louis counties, as well as the City of St. Louis, to provide drivers with daily information on

expected road closures and diversions. AT&T further asserts that MoDOT has requested AT&T to provide 511 service so that callers may access the travel information service.<sup>2</sup>

Before the Commission acts upon AT&T's request for expedited approval of its tariffs, it will notify MoDOT and give it an opportunity to respond.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Missouri Public Service Commission's Data Center is ordered to serve notice of AT&T's tariff filings to the Missouri Department of Transportation.

2. Should the Missouri Department of Transportation wish to file a recommendation regarding Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri's Motion for Expedited Treatment, and its accompanying tariffs, it shall do so no later than 8:00 a.m. on April 5, 2007.

3. This order shall become effective on April 3, 2007.
