ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

On June 29, 2012, Mark Twain Rural Telephone Company issued a tariff that will alter its state access tariff provisions regarding intrastate Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) traffic. Along with its tariff, Mark Twain filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the tariff on an expedited basis so it can go into effect on July 13.

Before acting on Mark Twain's tariff, the Commission will require a recommendation from its Staff. The Commission will also establish a deadline for any other party that wants to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Mark Twain Rural Telephone Company's tariff no later than July 6, 2012.

2. Any other party that wants to file a recommendation regarding Mark Twain Rural Telephone Company's tariff shall do so no later than July 6, 2012.

3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
