

MOTION FOR LEAVE TO AMEND APPLICATION

Comes now **TELIGENT SERVICES, INC.** ("TSI" or the "Company") and pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(21) moves for leave to amend its application in the referenced matter. In support thereof, the Company submits the following:

1. Since the time the Company's application was filed in this case, several rules of the Commission have been revised or rescinded and the list of waivers requested by the Company in its application are now out of date. Accordingly, TSI requests leave to amend paragraph 14 of its application by interlineation to reflect the statutes and rules, as they have been revised, for which the Company requests waiver.

2. The Company asks leave to amend paragraph 14 of its application so that it should hereafter read as follows:

22. TSI also respectfully requests, pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo 1994 that the Commission suspend, waive or modify the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as it relates to the regulation of the Applicant as a competitive basic exchange and local exchange company:



Pursuant to Section 5.0 of the Interconnection Agreement for Missouri dated the December 4, 1998 ("Agreement") by and between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company ("SWBT") and Teligent, Inc., SWBT hereby consents to the assignment of the Agreement from Teligent, Inc. to its affiliate, Teligent Services, Inc., effective on the 21st day of April, 2000 subject to the following terms and conditions: provided, however, that such assignment is not inconsistent with any applicable law (including, Teligent Services Inc.'s obligation to obtain proper Commission certification and approvals). As a condition of this assignment, Teligent Services, Inc. agrees to reimburse SWBT for any costs incurred by SWBT to accommodate or recognize under this Agreement Teligent Services, Inc. including any requested or required (i) modification by SWBT to its OSS, databases, methods and procedures and records (e.g., billing, inventory, interfaces and etc.) and (ii) network facilities rearrangement. SWBT shall have no obligation to proceed with such activities until the Parties agree upon the charges that apply to such activities.
