NOTICE CLOSING CASE

On January 18, 2000, BroadSpan Communications, Inc. d/b/a Primary Network Communications, Inc. (PNC) filed a Dismissal by which it voluntarily dismissed its petition for arbitration. PNC's Dismissal indicates that PNC and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) have resolved all outstanding issues by agreeing to amendments to their interconnection agreement. Also on January 18, SWBT filed a Response indicating that it concurs with PNC that all issues have been resolved and that there is no need for arbitration by the Commission.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), PNC may voluntarily dismiss its petition prior to the filing of evidence without action by the Commission. PNC has dismissed its petition and there is no need for any further action by the Commission. Therefore, this case may be closed.
