#### **MOTION TO FILE**

#### STAFF FINAL ELECTRIC INCIDENT REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for this Motion to File its report concerning Evaluation of Kansas City Power & Light Company's System Performance and Employee Safety and Training Programs states:

- 1. The Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) established this case, for the purpose of receiving information from Kansas City Power & Light (KCPL) concerning the February 17, 1999 Hawthorn Station explosion, pursuant to Sections 393.130.1 and 393.140(1), (2), (3), (5), (9) and (10) RSMo (Supp. 1999).
- 2. On February 17, 1999, there was an explosion at KCPL's Hawthorn Station involving Boiler No. 5 in which the boiler was completely destroyed.
- 3. In its Report and Order in Case No. EC-99-553, the Commission ordered Staff to "... investigate and report to the Commission as to whether or not the performance of Kansas City Power & Light Company's system declined over the past decade" and "whether Kansas City Power & Light Company has provided adequate and appropriate training to its employees" and to file that report in this case.
  - 4. The Report the Commission ordered above is attached.

5. Staff has designated most of the figures "Highly Confidential" and is filing both Non Proprietary and HC versions.

WHEREFORE the Staff requests that the Commission accept for filing this Evaluation of Kansas City Power & Light Company's System Performance and Employee Safety and Training Programs.
