

MOTION TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL"), Respondent, and for its Motion To Establishe Procedural Schedule states:

1. On February 9, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an Order directing parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than March 1, 2000.
2. On February 23, 2000,. the Commission held a prehearing conference in this matter. The Complainant was not present or represented by counsel. However, following the prehearing conference, counsel for KCPL, Staff, and Public Counsel telephoned Kathyrn R. Persley, who indicated that she was intending to represent the Complainant in this matter. The parties discussed the need to propose a procedural schedule in this matter. KCPL's counsel agreed to fax to Ms. Persley, as well as counsel for the Staff and Public Counsel, a draft procedural schedule. Later, on February 23, 2000, the procedural schedule discussed below was transmitted to all counsel, including Ms. Persley, seeking their approval. On February 29, 2000, the undersigned counsel for KCPL received the attached letter from Ms. Persley which stated that she was no longer

representing Mr. Banks. No further contact with Mr. Banks or Ms. Persley has occurred on this matter as of the filing of this pleading.


3. Pursuant to the Commission Order, KCPL hereby proposes the following procedural schedule:




