

SECOND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT


COMES NOW Western Communications, Inc. ("Western" or "Applicant"), pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.080(16) and for its Second Motion for Expedited Treatment states to the Commission as follows:

1. Applicant has herein filed an Application for Approval of the Transfer of Assets and Subscribers of Logix Communications Corp. and for Waiver of Commission Rule 33.150.

2. An expedited decision herein is essential to afford Applicant full opportunity to conclude the planned acquisition of the assets and customer base of Logix Communications Corp. in a timely manner to enable a seamless transition in service providers without interruption of service. Applicant only recently obtained written approval of the bankruptcy court and completed the documentation of its Application. Accordingly, it has filed this Motion as soon as possible. Pursuant to agreements among, and representations made to the bankruptcy court by Logix, Western and other parties involved in the transition of customers and services, Applicant requests approval of the Application by October 4, 2002.

3. Applicant submits that there will be no undue negative effect on customers or the general public if the Commission acts as soon as possible and grants the requested relief.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests the Commission to expedite its handling of the Application on this case and issue its decision in this case before October 4, 2002.
