The Company has requested that their current interim rates be made permanent. Attached to their letter was a summary of their operations from May 1979 through December 31, 1981, which indicated the Company operated with a net loss of \$183.73 for that period.

We have reviewed the 1980 Annual Report which showed operating losses for both 1979 and 1980.

Conclusion: We believe the interim rates should be made permanent without the need for an audit or hearing.
