On June 13, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a response to the Commission's order further suspending the tariff sheets. In that response, GMO attaches a comparison of the company's latan 2 allocation and the Commission's latan 2 allocation with regard to the effects on revenue requirement of those allocations and the fuel adjustment clause rebasing issue. What GMO's attachment does not show are the numbers for the Commission's latan 2 Allocation with Rebasing. It would be helpful to the Commission to have these numbers in a similar format for an accurate comparison. In addition, the Commission directs its Staff to respond to the numbers presented by the company with regard to the allocation and fuel change due to the allocation.
