#### **ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION**

On March 23, 1998, Union Electric Company filed an application for authorization to manage sulphur dioxide emission allowance inventory. On April 6, the Commission issued an Order and Notice allowing proper persons the opportunity to request intervention. On May 6, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) timely filed an application to intervene. KCPL states that its interest in this case is in ensuring uniformity and consistency both in the treatment of sulfur dioxide emission allowances and in the treatment of the jurisdictional utilities seeking to manage their emissions allowances. KCPL believes that policies and procedures may be established in this case that will affect it. KCPL states that its interest is different from that of the general public, and cannot be adequately represented by any other party to the proceeding. No party opposed KCPL's application to intervene. The Commission finds that KCPL has an interest in this case different from that of the general public and should be allowed to intervene.

#### **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the application to intervene of Kansas City Power & 1. Light Company is granted.
