The Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation by May 24, 2010, regarding Rosebud Telephone LLC's application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunications services. On May 24, Staff filed a motion indicating it was unable to file its recommendation until it can collect additional information. Staff expects to be able to file its recommendation by June 1.

Staff's motion is reasonable and the Commission will grant the additional time Staff requests.
