MOTION TO CORRECT REPORT AND ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC AND MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri")

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and states as follows:

1. On December 12, 2012, the Commission issued its Report and Order in this

proceeding, to be effective on December 22, 2012.

2. The Report and Order contains the following two sentences on page 5:

Over \$100 million of that increase is related to Ameren Missouri's increased net fuel costs and would otherwise be recoverd by the company through its fuel adjustment clause. Another \$89 million of that increase is for the cost of increasing Ameren Missouri's energy efficiency efforts under Missouri's Energy Efficiency Investment Act, MEEIA.

3. The numbers contained in these two sentences are incorrect. In the first sentence, approximately \$84 million of the increase is related to increased net fuel costs. In the second sentence, approximately \$79.6 million of the increase is for the cost of increasing Ameren Missouri's energy efficiency efforts under the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act ("MEEIA"). Ameren Missouri has reviewed these figures with the Commission Staff, and the Staff has confirmed that the numbers recited herein are correct. In addition, the word "recovered" in the first sentence is missing an "e."

4. It is important to include correct numbers in the Report and Order because

Ameren Missouri will report these numbers to the Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC")

in an informational filing addressing the rate case. Any inconsistency between the numbers

reflected in the Commission's Report and Order and those reflected in the SEC filing will create

unnecessary confusion about the impact of the Report and Order among investors and the general public.

5. Ameren Missouri requests that the Commission correct its Report and Order as promptly as possible. This pleading was filed as soon as it could have been given the issuance date of the Report and Order.

6. Ameren Missouri is authorized to represent that the Staff has no objection to the relief sought herein.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission issue its order correcting the two sentences in the Report and Order as indicated herein.
