On June 23, 2014, Time Warner Cable Midwest LLC (TWCMW), d/b/a Time Warner Cable filed a Notice of Change Application for authorization to provide video service in additional political subdivisions. Time Warner's application was not complete in that it failed to contain a signed affidavit pursuant to §67.2679.7, RSMo.

Time Warner's filing is deficient and the Commission will not take action on this application until this deficiency is corrected. The Commission will leave the file open until July 7, 2014, to allow Time Warner to correct the deficiency. If no response is filed by that time, the Commission will reject the application and close the file.
