MOTION FOR FINDING OF NECESSITY OF RULEMAKING

COMES NOW the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Director" and "Program"), by and through the Missouri Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Office of General Counsel, and for his Motion for Finding of Necessity of Rulemaking ("Motion") states as follows:

- 1. Attached, as Attachment A is the Director's recommendation to the Commission on the proposed rulemaking. Included in the recommendation is an analysis of the fiscal impact and effectiveness of the rule, both to the State as well as to any private or public person or entity affected by this rulemaking.
- 2. The Director proposes to amend Rule 4 CSR 240-120.100 to clarify the requirements to which new manufactured homes are to be set up or installed.
- 3. This rulemaking is necessary to assist the Manufactured Housing Department in making determinations about the proper set up of new manufactured homes.

WHEREFORE, the Director respectfully requests that the Commission, based upon reasonably available empirical data including an assessment of the effectiveness and costs both to the State and to any private or public person or entity affected, find that the proposed



amendment to 4 CSR 240-120.100 (Code), is necessary to update and make uniform the rules pertaining to manufactured housing and for such other reasons as stated herein.

4 CSR 240-120.100 - Code is being amended to clarify the requirements to which new manufactured homes are to be set up or installed. The rule generally specifies that new manufactured homes shall be set up or installed according to the manufacturer's installation instruction manual.

The new rule is necessary to assist the Manufactured Housing Department in making determinations about the proper set up of new manufactured homes. There is no fiscal impact resulting from this proposed rule amendment.

Staff recommends that the Commission find that a rulemaking to propose 4 CSR 240-120.100 is necessary.
