## ORDER REJECTING APPLICATION AND CLOSING CASE

Effective Date: July 16, 2008

On July 10, 2008, a consultant for Windjammer Communication LLC filed an application for video service authorization. Under Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.010(13) “pleadings” are defined as “any application...filed in a case.” Because the application is defined as a pleading, it must be filed in compliance with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(1), which requires that pleadings be signed by a licensed attorney or, if appearing on behalf of themselves, a non-attorney. It is evident that the consultant of Windjammer has filed this application on behalf of the company. Thus, for purposes of this application, the company must be represented by an attorney.

Because it does not comply with the Commission rules, the Commission must reject this application. Further, the Commission will close this case. If it wishes to do so, Windjammer may file another application through an attorney in accordance with the Commission's procedural rules.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The application for video service authorization filed by Windjammer

Communication LLC, is rejected

2. This order shall become effective on July 16, 2008.
3. This case may be closed on July 17, 2008.
