## MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves that the Commission cancel Phonetel Technologies, Inc.'s (Phonetel) certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services in Missouri. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On April 25, 1990, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone services, to Phonetel Technologies, in Case No. TA-90-222.
- 2. On September 30, 2007, the Chief Financial Officer of Phonetel sent a letter to the Commission, requesting that the Commission eliminate the registration of Phonetl. (The Commission received this letter on March 7, 2008, a true and accurate copy of the letter is attached hereto as Attachment A).
- 3. The letter indicated that Phonetel no longer operates private coin phones in Missouri.
  - 4. The services to be discontinued are private pay telephone services.
- 5. Phonetel has past due assessments due to the Commission for the years 1999 and 2000. These past due assessments were not pursued because of the bankruptcy of Phonetel.
- 6. Phonetel is reflected as being in good standing by the Missouri Secretary of State's website.

7. Because Phonetel has requested to be eliminated from registration, effectively a request to cancel its certificate, and because it is not providing private pay telephone service in Missouri, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling the company's certificate.

8. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2006), which provides:

"Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of Phonetel Technologies, Inc. to provide private pay telephone services in Missouri.
